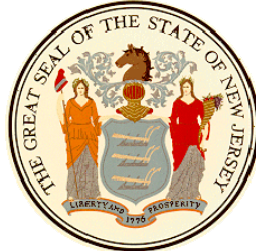

In 2011 there were 74,014 treatment admissions and 72,324 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 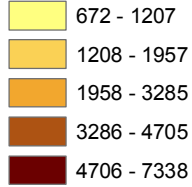

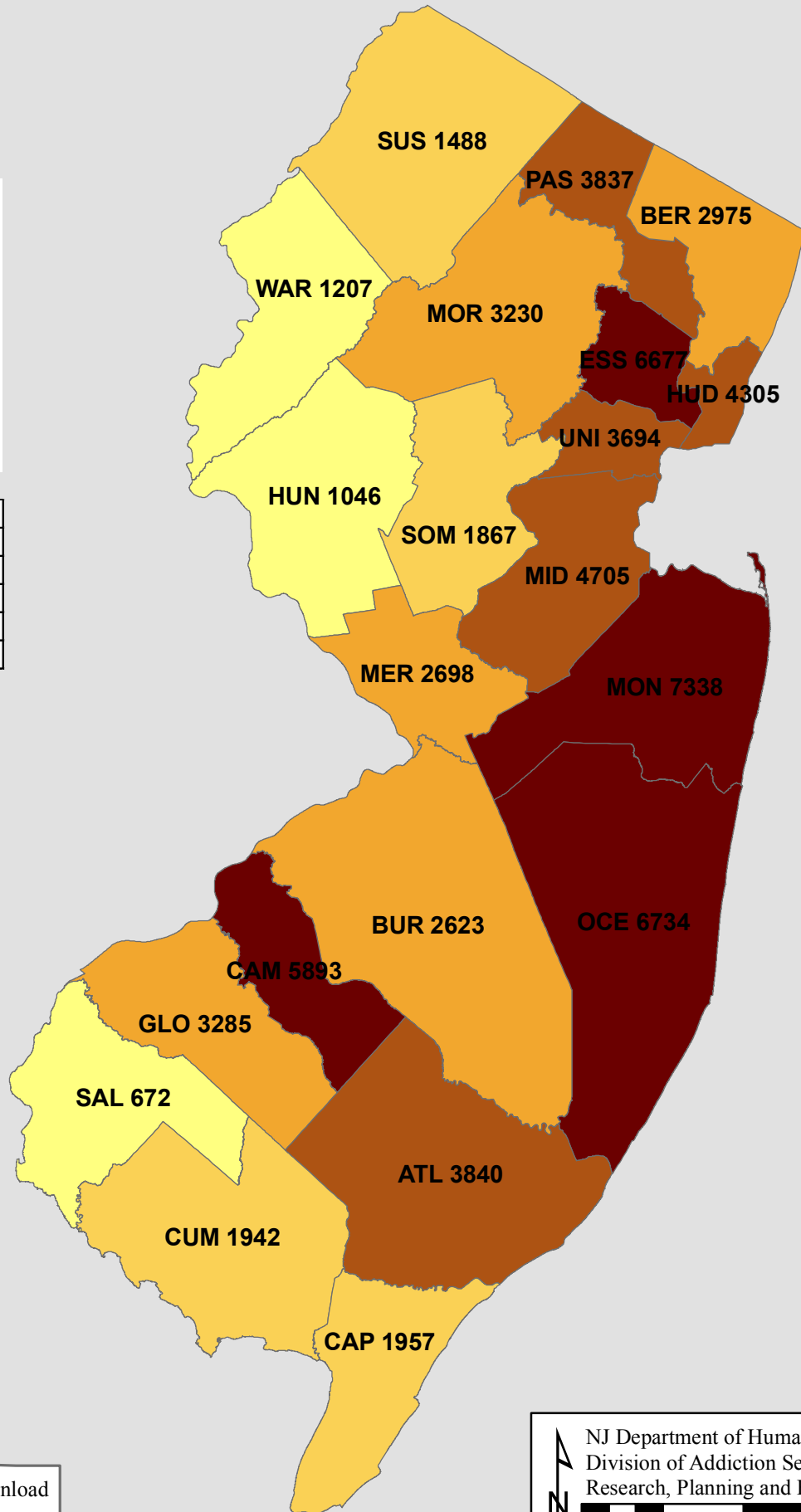

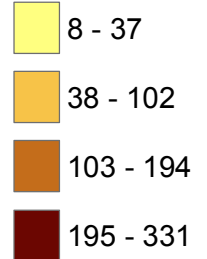

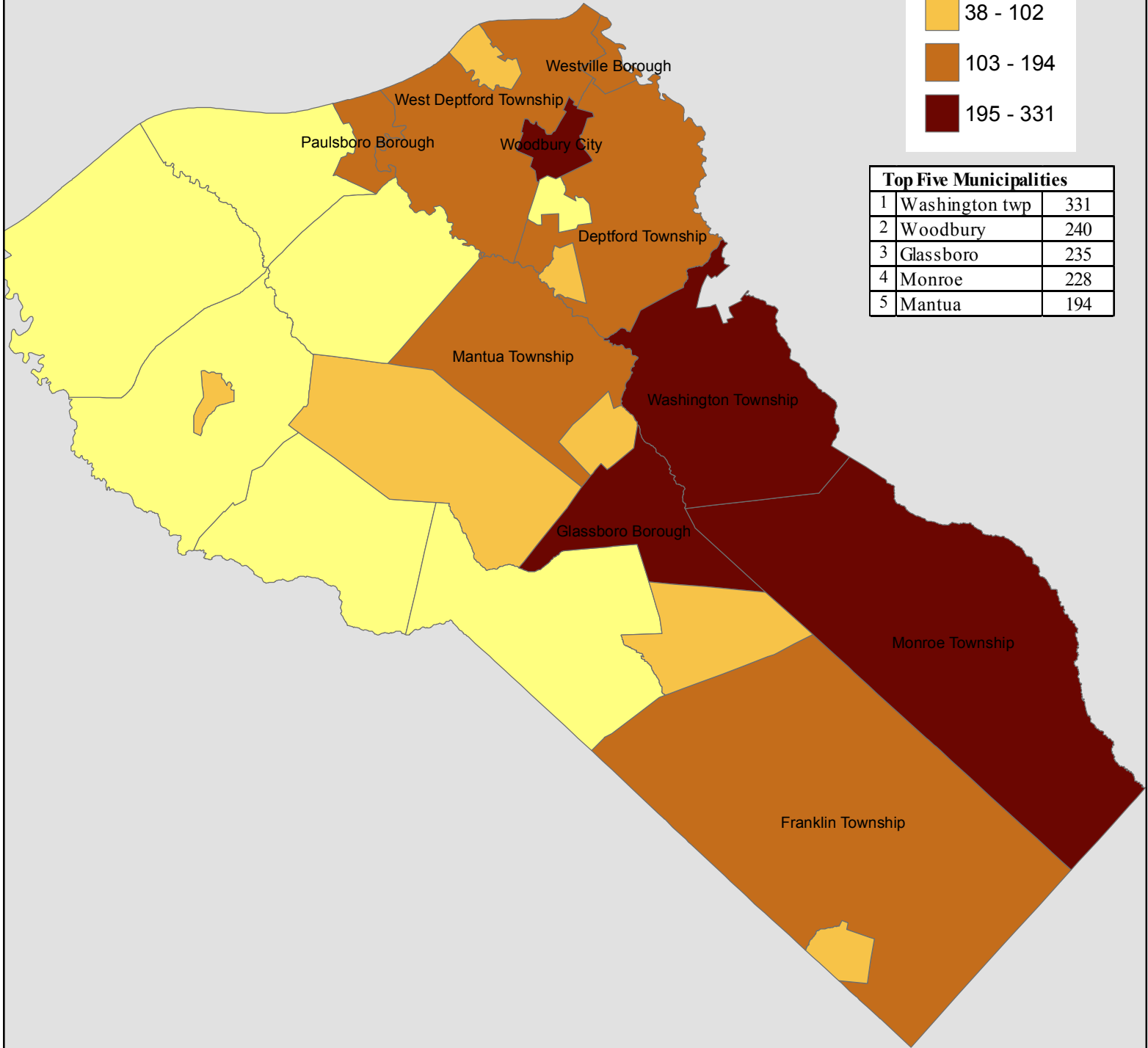
2011 Gloucester County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
