The Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Developmental Disabilities (Division), Office for the Prevention of Developmental Disabilities (OPDD), is soliciting proposals to assist DHS in reducing the incidence of intellectual and developmental disabilities in New Jersey. Funding for approved proposals will be provided for Statewide Projects (Projects must address prevention activities that will have an impact throughout the State) as well as Special Projects (Projects that address the unique needs of populations and/or specific underserved regions throughout the State).

Amount of funding available:

Annualized awards totaling \$753,000 through this initiative are anticipated. Contracts of up to \$125,000 per year, subject to State appropriation, may be available for programs that are Statewide, and grants up to \$40,000 per year, subject to State appropriation, is expected to be available for special projects.
