To Whom It May Concern:

This correspondence provides you with advance notice that the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired (CBVI) intends to readopt and propose amendments to N.J.A.C 10:91. This chapter establishes the organizational and general policy provisions for the programs administered within the agency, including education, independent living, business enterprise program, and prevention services. Vocational Rehabilitation and the Independent Living-Older Blind programs are also administered by the agency, pursuant to the Workforce Opportunity and Prevention Act, 29 U.S.C. 3101 et seq., for which the State obtains funding in order to administer a broad network of services for individuals who are blind, visually impaired, and deaf-blind.

The proposed amendments will include:

- revisions to the CBVI fee schedule including, but not limited to, removing outdated categories and updating fee amounts.

This notice provides you with an opportunity to submit informal comments regarding CBVI's plan to propose the amendments described above within 30 days from the publication of this notice on the Department's website.
