**DGE Announces September 2012 Casino Win Results**

ATLANTIC CITY —

Based upon filings with the Division of Gaming Enforcement, total casino win fell 6.3 percent in September 2012 to \$276 million. Slot machine win fell 3.2 percent, to \$198.4 million, while table game win decreased by 13.6 percent, to \$77.6 million.

Casinos paid \$18.7 million in taxes on their gross revenues in September. That money, 8 percent of taxable gross revenue, goes into the Casino Revenue Fund, which pays for programs that benefit qualifying senior citizens and people with disabilities. In addition, the casino industry incurred \$3.4 million in reinvestment obligations based on their gross revenues for the month. Casinos are required to reinvest 1.25 percent of gross revenues in projects approved by the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority.

For the first nine months of the year, casinos won \$2.4 billion which is down 4.8 percent from the same period in 2011. Win from slot machines was down 2.6 percent and win from table games was down 10 percent for the nine month period.

As reported earlier today in a press release issued by the Atlantic City Convention and Visitors Authority, the number of occupied room nights for the 12 Atlantic City casino properties increased by 157,624 (to 1,588,091 occupied room nights) in June, July and August compared to 1,430,467 occupied room nights the prior period. This is an 11% increase over the same period in 2011.

Win reflects the net amount of money won by casinos. It is not profit.
