Additional Information for Active Vendors Report and Keys to Interpret Status Codes

The **Active Vendors Report** is an alphabetical listing of enterprises that have been vendor registered by the Division and/or have filed an application with the Division for a Casino Service Industry Enterprise License. The report is updated daily.

In addition to its vendor identification number, address and telephone number, each enterprise appears on the Active Vendor Report with a code in the Registration / License Status ("REG/LIC STAT) column that denotes the current registration or license status held. Additionally, some enterprises also have a code in the License Type ("APPL LOG# TRAILER") column. These enterprises have applied for or have been issued Casino Service Industry Enterprise ("CSI") licenses. The APPL LOG# TRAILER code denotes the type of license applied for or held.

It is important to note that enterprises that have applied for but not yet been granted a license PURSUANT TO <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 5:12-92a may only conduct business upon the filing and approval of a transactional waiver petition (<u>N.J.A.C.</u> 13:69J-1.2B). Enterprises that have been licensed may conduct business without going through this step. So you must remember to read and interpret both the REG/LIC STAT and APPL LOG# TRAILER codes.

Keys to interpret the REG/LIC STAT and APPL LOG# TRAILER codes follow:

An enterprise with a REG/LIC STAT code of "L" has been issued a CSI license.

A "T" in the Relationship ("REL") column denotes a trade name. Every record with a "T" in REL code is a duplicate of another record that reflects the legal business name of the enterprise.
