Constituted 1 October 1987 in the Delaware, New Jersey, Virginia, and Vermont Army National Guards as the 150th Aviation, a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System; concurrently organized from new and existing units from the 3-112th Field Artillery and 50th Combat Aviation Battalion, with Headquarters at West Trenton, New Jersey, to consist of the 1st Battalion and Companies D, E, and F, elements of the 50th Armored Division.

Reorganized 1 September 1990 in the Delaware and New Jersey Army National Guards to consist of the 1st Aviation Helicopter Battalion and Companies D, E, and F, elements of the 50th Armored Division.

Reorganized 1 October 1993 in the New Jersey Army National Guard to consist of the 1st Aviation Battalion (Attack) and Companies A, B, C, and E of the 29th Infantry Division (Light).

Reorganized 1 September 2003 in the Delaware and New Jersey Army National Guards to consist of the 1st Aviation Battalion (General Support) and Companies A, B, and C, of the 42nd Infantry Division (Mechanized).

Reorganized 1 February 2006 in the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and West Virginia Army National Guards to consist of the 1st Battalion (Assault) and Companies A, B, C, and D of the 28th Infantry.
