



18th Annual Delaware River Sojourn: *Adventures on the Delaware*
Sunday, June 24 through Saturday, June 30, 2012

The Delaware River Sojourn is a guided paddling trip on the Delaware River, combining canoeing/kayaking, camping, educational programs, historical interpretation, and more.

- The Sojourn is held during June in celebration of National Rivers Month.
- Registration for the 2012 Delaware Sojourn is open! Participants can register for the entire trip or the day(s) of their choice.
- Register before June 15 and save \$10 off of the daily rates.
- Registration Fees (pre-June 15):
 - Adults (includes children over 15): \$80/day
 - Children (15 and under): \$50/day
 - Additional one-time insurance fee of \$5 per person for this event sanctioned by the American Canoe Association (ACA), except for current ACA members.
 - Fees cover: guided river trip, single or tandem kayak rental (with paddle and PFD), shuttle transportation, educational programs, 2-3 meals/day, a souvenir T-shirt, and optional overnight camping sites.

Wednesday, June 27: Driftstone on the Delaware Campground to Martins Creek Access (Pa.)

Thursday, June 28: Martins Creek Access to Easton's Scott Park Access (Pa.)

Friday, June 29: Easton's Scott Park Access to Riegelsville (N.J.)

Saturday, June 30: Bristol (Pa.) to Palmyra Cove Nature Park (N.J.)
