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Addressing the Highlands Master plan revision, The issue of landowner equity has never been addressed, although in the original legislation passed. Landowners were stripped of the value of development rights, with no compensation. No so called, Water uses have ever been utilized and as a mandate to any water value ever being utilized in the Highlands, a fee for water, marked to compensate landowners, must be included. Also the 88 acres used as a science for septic development, has no realistic basis, and should be dramatically reduced to meet some development standards.
