Response/Recovery Situation Report

November 2, 2011 - 3:00 p.m.

The NJROIC and NJOEM continue to monitor a winter storm event in coordination with the NWS. At 4:00PM, Saturday, October 29, 2011 and State Emergency Operations Center was activated and will remain staffed as long as conditions dictate.

Governor Christie has signed an order due to the current emergency that lifts restrictions placed on commercial carrier hours of service relative to work associated with utility restoration. This is limited to operators of vehicles involved in the restoration of utility service within the State of New Jersey. **Expires on Nov 7, 2011.**

NJ Transit

Service from Hackettstown to Lake Hopatcong remains suspended.

Message for the remainder of the week: Morris & Essex Line midday trains (9:30 a.m.- 3:30 p.m.) may experience 15-20 minute delays this week due to ongoing storm-related repairs.

ARCL service remains suspended between Hammonton and Atco for a trespasser incident. In addition to passengers using NJT Bus #554, a bus bridge is being provided to accommodate passengers.
