### NOTICE OF ONLINE PARTNERSHIP SOLICITATION FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S "UPHOLDING THE RULE OF LAW AND PREVENTING WRONGFUL CONVICTIONS" Federal Fiscal FFY 2018 COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM

Take notice that, the Department of Law and Public Safety (Department) is preparing an application seeking funding under the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance's "Upholding the Rule of Law and Preventing Wrongful Convictions" FFY 2018 Competitive Grant Program. As described in the grant solicitation, applicants applying for Category 1 funding are required to include in their applications a partnership between a state or local prosecutor's office and an organization or entity dedicated to ensuring just convictions and/or acquittals.

The Department is preparing an application under Category 1 of the grant opportunity. To fulfill the grant's application requirements, the Department is seeking at least one entity that is dedicated to ensuring just convictions and/or acquittals as a partner in the Department's grant program.

Entities should include information on their organization, their capabilities and competencies in the areas of reviewing convictions, and describe how they will be an effective partner with the Department.

It is further in the Department's sole discretion whether to apply for funding under this grant opportunity or for any continuing funding program.**

**Please note that this is not a solicitation to receive grant funding. The Department does not anticipate making any subgrants under this grant application.**
