DUTIES: Under the direction of the Engineer in Charge of Maintenance or other supervisory official at the New Jersey Training School or the Juvenile Medium Security Facility, assists the craftsmen and/or independently performs basic maintenance, construction, repair, or mechanical adjustment work involved in varied types of buildings, building facilities and/or building utilities, and highway and bridge construction; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS
