present that:

COUNT ONE

(Promoting Prostitution - Fourth Degree)


on or about June 24, 2011, at the City of Atlantic City, in the County of Atlantic, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, while at the Trump Taj Mahal Hotel and Casino, knowingly did promote prostitution by knowingly permitting a place controlled by the actor, alone or in association with another, to be regularly used for prostitution or promotion of prostitution, or failure to make a reasonable effort to abate such use by ejecting the tenant, notifying law enforcement authorities, or other legally available means, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:34-1(b)(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Obstructing Administration of Law - Fourth Degree)


on or about June 24, 2011, at the City of Atlantic City, in the County of Atlantic, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, while at the Trump Taj Mahal Hotel and Casino, purposely did obstruct, impair or prevent the administration of law or other governmental function thereby obstructing the investigation or detection of a crime or the prosecution of "P.A." for a crime, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:29-1, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
