Racing Commission Proposes New Rules to Establish Exchange Wagering

Date of Proposal: June 16, 2014

Proposal Number: PRN 2014-095

Proposal Description: The primary objective of proposed new N.J.A.C. 13:74C is to

establish the rules necessary for implementation of exchange wagering, a new type of pari-mutuel betting on horse races that was authorized by the Exchange Wagering Act of 2011. The Act provides that the New Jersey Racing Commission shall have full power to prescribe rules, regulations and conditions under which exchange wagering may be

conducted in New Jersey.
