COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy - First Degree)

ERNESTINE BOWMAN

GLEN BOWMAN, SR.

JESSICA COPELAND

TOKINA WILLIAMS

and

GLEN BOWMAN, JR.

who are named as defendants herein, and other individuals whose identities are both known and unknown to the Grand Jurors, who

are named as co-conspirators but not as defendants herein, between on or about June 1, 2014, and on or about October 1, 2014, at the City of Clifton, in the County of Passaic, and at the City of South Hackensack, in the County of Bergen, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crimes of human trafficking, endangering the welfare of a child, and promoting prostitution did agree that:

- A. One or more of them knowingly would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crimes, or
- B. One or more of them knowingly would aid in the planning, solicitation or commission of said crimes, that is:
- 1. Knowingly did hold, recruit, lure, entice, harbor, transport, provide or obtain, by any means, a child under 18 years of age, to engage in sexual activity, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:13-8a(3);
- 2. Knowingly did procure or attempt to procure a person to engage in sexual activity, or to provide labor or services, whether for himself or another person, knowing that the person provided or to be provided was a victim of human trafficking, or under circumstances in which a reasonable person would conclude that there was a substantial likelihood that the person was a victim of human trafficking, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:13-9;

- 3. Knowingly did engage in sexual conduct which would impair or debauch the morals of a child under 18 years of age, that is C.P., born November 15, 1997, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4a(1); and
- 4. Knowingly did promote prostitution of a child under 18, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:34-lb(3).

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

between on or about June 1, 2014 and on or about October 1, 2014, at the City of Clifton, in the County of Passaic, and at the City of South Hackensack, in the County of Bergen, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly, did hold, recruit, lure, entice, harbor, transport, provide or obtain, a child under 18 years of age, that is, C.P. born November 15, 1997, to engage in sexual activity, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:13-8a(3) and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - First Degree)

(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - Second Degree)

(Promoting Prostitution - Second Degree)

on or about October 1, 2014, at the City of South Hackensack, in the County of Bergen, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly, did engage in prostitution with a person under the age of 18, and/or did enter into or remain in a house of prostitution for the purpose of engaging in sexual activity with a child under 18, or did solicit or request a child under the age of 18 to engage in sexual activity, that is, C.P. born November 15, 1997, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:34-1b(7), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWELVE

(Promoting Prostitution - Third Degree)

between on or about June 1, 2014 and on or about October 1, 2014, at the City of Clifton, in the County of Passaic, and at the City of South Hackensack, in the County of Bergen, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did promote prostitution by transporting a person into or within this State with the purpose to promote that person's engaging in prostitution, or procuring or paying for transportation with that purpose, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:34-la(4)(f), N.J.S.A. 2C:34-lb(2), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of same.
