Female Reentry Program Highlighted in Courier-Post

Editorial by Vice-Chairwoman Ross describes FORGE-Camden

TRENTON – Today’s edition of the Courier-Post features an editorial written by State Parole Board Vice-Chairwoman Yolette C. Ross. The editorial describes the Female Offender Reentry Group Effort (FORGE) Camden, which will provide a gender-specific, one-stop location for rehabilitative services aimed at female parolees who are already in Camden.

“Helping these women turn away from crime is more than a service for the women. It also helps their children and families, saves untold taxpayer costs in criminal investigations, victim injuries and incarceration, and enhances the safety of families across New Jersey,” the editorial states.
