CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – UPDATE

**** EAST 12TH STREET AND 4TH AVENUE, CITY OF PATERSON****

(Newark) – The Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission (PVSC) recently began with the scheduled rehabilitation of the Main Interceptor Sewer within 4th Avenue between East 12th Street and River Road, within the City of Paterson. This work is part of PVSC's scheduled rehabilitation of the Main Interceptor Sewer and will continue through mid-February 2016.

As a result of these activities, the public may notice a period of *construction inactivity* from mid-February through the end of March, 2016. However, on or around April 1, 2016, rehabilitation work along East 12th Street and 4th Avenue will resume and continue until October 2016. (*This is being done to coincide with additional work along 5th Avenue between the NJ Transit Railroad and East 11th Street in Paterson*).

The Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission recognizes that this project will have an impact on the local community and we apologize for any inconvenience; however the infrastructure work is essential and necessary to the health and safety of all residents within the PVSC Service District.

Throughout the course of the project, PVSC will continue to provide updates to residents and commuters regarding the status of the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
