**PVSC Holds Reorganization Meeting
*Tucci and Quintana Re-Elected to Leadership Posts***

Newark, NJ – Commissioners Thomas Tucci, Jr., and Luis Quintana were re-elected Chairman and Vice Chairman, respectively, at the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission’s (“PVSC”) Annual Reorganization Meeting yesterday. In addition, Commissioner Elizabeth Calabrese was re-elected Board Treasurer. Albert Lukin was re-appointed as the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners.

Commissioners John Cosgrove, James Doran, Joseph Isola, Hector Lora, Brendan Murphy, and C. Lawrence Crump, as well as several members of the PVSC management team, were also present at the virtual meeting. Commissioner Calabrese has served as a commissioner since 2015, Commissioners Doran and Isola have served as commissioners since 2017, and Commissioners Cosgrove, Lora and Murphy have served as commissioners since 2019, Commissioner Crump has served as a commissioner since 2023.
