## **Legislative History**

Phillipsburg Town was formed from Phillipsburg Township in 1861. In 1903 and 1929, additional territory was added from the township, which had been renamed Lopatcong in 1863. The Phillipsburg High School apparently also enrolled students from surrounding townships and villages, such as Harmony, Stewartsville and New Village.
