Mildred Barry Garvin Prize

The **Mildred Barry Garvin Prize** is an award of \$1,500 to a New Jersey teacher, guidance counselor, or school librarian for outstanding teaching of black American history in kindergarten through high school or outstanding performance in a related activity such as developing curriculum materials. One prize is awarded annually. Nominations for the 2012 prize must be postmarked by October 6, 2011. Those for the 2013 prize must be postmarked by October 5, 2012. Self-nomination is possible. A nomination form for this prize is included on the following page.
