The new roadway will be built with an alignment shifted by 5 feet to 8 feet to the east.

Funding may be used to acquire landscape parcels, scenic easements, or farmland preservation easements on land abutting or within the viewshed of Route 57, as well as to advance landscape, pedestrian safety and operational improvements within the towns and villages in the corridor. This program will benefit Smart Growth in the corridor.

This is a multi-year funded project under the provisions of Section 13 of P.L. 1995, c.108. Total right of way cost is \$10,000,000.
