Background

The NJDOT is improving U.S. Route 130 as well as improving the intersections at Adams Lane, Dillion Court and Wood Avenue.

The Project

The proposed improvements will add a lane in each direction of U.S. Route 130 and Adams Lane; improve traffic flow at and around the intersection by adding new movements, restrict unsafe turning movements and replace the existing traffic signal; improve drainage; relocate existing utilities; and provide a preemptive traffic signal in front of the Fire Station along Rt. 130.
