

Subsection 401.03.03.D of the 2007 Standard Specifications requires that HMA weigh tickets be signed and sealed by a certified weighmaster. Because many HMA suppliers restrict truck drivers from leaving their trucks as part of plant safety protocols, the requirement creates logistical difficulties for drivers to get a weigh master certified ticket for each truckload.

The Department has decided to permit HMA suppliers to submit, in lieu of weighmaster signed and sealed tickets, either of the following with the last load of a project's daily or shift production:

1. Copies of all weigh tickets from the days production signed and sealed by the weighmaster
2. A summary of the truck net weights signed and sealed by the weighmaster.

Construction personnel will not be required to verify either of these submissions against the original weigh tickets. Construction personnel are still required to collect and inspect each ticket as the loads are delivered to the project site.
