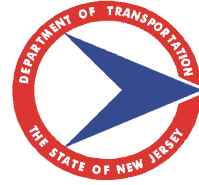

Baseline Document Change Announcement

ANNOUNCEMENT: BDC12S-12

DATE: October 12, 2012

SUBJECT: Disposal of Unclassified Excavation
- Revision to Subparts 201.03.01 and 202.03.03 of the 2007 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction

Subparts 201.03.01 and 202.03.03 of the 2007 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction have been revised.

Subpart 201.03.01 has been revised to include appropriate reference for the disposal of clearing site material.

Subpart 202.03.01 has been revised to add “pavement removal” to the list of material to be excluded from the unclassified material.

The following revisions have been incorporated into the Standard Input SI2007 as of October 12, 2012.

201.03.01 Clearing Site

B. Clearing and Grubbing.

THE FOLLOWING IS ADDED:

Dispose of material and debris as specified in 201.03.09.

202.03.03 Excavating Unclassified Material

A. Excavating.

THE FIRST PARAGRAPH IS CHANGED TO:

The Department, as the generator, is solely responsible for the designation of excavated material. Unclassified excavation consists of excavation and management of material of whatever nature encountered, except for regulated material, pavement removal and acid producing soil.

Implementation Code R (ROUTINE)

Changes must be implemented in all applicable Department projects scheduled for Final Design Submission at least one month after the date of the BDC announcement. This will allow designers to make necessary plan, specifications, and estimate/proposal changes without requiring the need for an addenda or postponement of advertisement or receipt of bids.
