

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 45:16A-1 et seq., the “State Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVACR) Contracting License Law”, contractors currently practicing in the HVAC trade must obtain the new HVACR license in order to continue to perform these services. At this time the license is assigned to an individual and must be linked to the company in order to comply with the provisions of the act. It our understanding the State Board of Examiners for Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration has accepted applications to grandfather in current HVAC contractors. At this time, the Division of Property Management and Construction (DPMC) is revising the Request for Classification Form (DPMC-27) and project database to include the new HVACR trade (C032). During this transition period, contractors currently classified with the DPMC in the HVAC trade (C039) must provide a copy of the filed grandfather application with a cancelled check or license in order to be assigned the new HVACR trade (C032) classification and maintain their ability to bid on HVACR projects.
