NEW EXTENSION

New Jersey State Income Tax Deadline Extended to April 26 For Storm Victims

TRENTON -- The New Jersey Department of the Treasury announced today that the State's Division of Taxation will follow the Internal Revenue Service's further extension to April 26 of the filing deadline for those state income tax returns due April 17. Returns and payments postmarked or received by April 26, 2007, will be considered timely filed.

Earlier this week the filing deadline for New Jersey taxpayers affected by the April 16 storm had been extended an additional two days to April 19, 2007.

For the purposes of this extension, affected taxpayers include individuals located in flooded areas, as well as those whose tax records, including documents needed for making tax deposits, are located in those areas. The transmission of returns and remittances that are submitted electronically must be completed by midnight, April 26, in order to avoid applicable penalties. Paper submissions must be postmarked by that date as well. Those filing paper submissions should write "APRIL 16 STORM" at the top of the form in ink in order to be considered for this tax relief.
