

RESOLUTION (SAMPLE ONLY)

AUTHORIZATION FOR THE COUNTY STAFF TO PROCESS AN INVOLUNTARY DISABILITY RETIREMENT APPLICATION

WHEREAS the County of Bergen has employed a Correction Sergeant at its Columbus Correctional Facility* and

WHEREAS the Correction Sergeant is an active member of the PFRS; and

WHEREAS the Correction Sergeant has nineteen years and 6 months of PFRS Service Credit, meeting the minimum service credit requirement of at least 4 years for PFRS and SPRS members; and

WHEREAS the County staff is of the opinion that the Correction Sergeant is totally and permanently disabled and no longer can perform his or her assigned duties based on the documentation supplied by professionals retained by the County; and

WHEREAS the County of Bergen is unable to provide an alternative to the PFRS covered position with duties capable of being performed by said Correction Sergeant; and

WHEREAS the Bergen County Sheriff has consented to the processing of the Involuntary Disability Retirement application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the governing body of this location that the administrator of Bergen County process an Involuntary Disability Retirement application for the Correction Sergeant at its Columbus Correctional Facility and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to all parties involved in the administration of this action.
