**Question #2**      **Section 3.1: Are there sample reports used in the past that would illustrate the deliverable.**

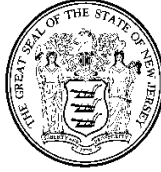
Answer          Sample reports are unavailable. Instead, the state prefers that bidders submit samples of bill comments they have prepared for their current clients with their bids.

Answer          Segal is the current contractor. The contract is being re-procured because the current contract term is coming to an end.

**Question #4**      **Section 4.4.4: Is the work under this RFP already in the State budget and what is the amount - or alternatively how much has been spent in the past for the services described in this RFP?**

Answer          The state typically spends approximately \$60,000 per year on these services.
