Question # 1 **May we obtain a copy of the prior audit report?**

Question # 6 **How much was this job bid for the last time? I am not sure how much to quote in my proposal.**

Question # 7 **Can I be provided with a copy of the previous bid proposal so that I can tailor mine in a similar format that is satisfactory to your requirements?**

Answer: See answer to Question #1. The directions in the RFP describe the format to be used.

Question # 8 **If I qualify as a small business does that limit my company's participation in the selection process to only the four contracts set aside in Section 1.1 of the RFP? Can a small business not being selected in the small business set-aside qualify for the remaining six contracts?**

Answer: It is the intent of this RFP that up to ten (10) contracts be awarded. The State intends to award forty percent (40%) of the contracts as set aside for small businesses registered with the State. The remaining sixty percent (60%) shall be awarded on an open competition basis. If a small business is not awarded one of the set-aside contracts, it shall then be eligible to compete for one of the remaining contracts.
