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Bridge deck reconstruction to begin on New Jersey Turnpike's Newark Bay-Hudson County Extension

WOODBIDGE, December 1, 2010 – Traffic between Interchanges 14 and 14A of the Newark Bay-Hudson County Extension of the New Jersey Turnpike will be shifted starting this week when work begins on the reconstruction of the bridge deck.

The project, which will be done in stages on the eastbound and westbound sides, is scheduled to be completed in October 2013. The current two lanes of travel will be maintained on both sides of the bridge during peak hours while the work is being done. There will be no shoulder lanes, but emergency pull-offs will be available in both directions for disabled vehicles.
