Shellfish Monitoring Plan for the Oyster Beds at the Mullica River  
Widening of the Garden State Parkway  
Interchange 30 to Interchange 80  
2005 Bond Issue Fund No. 20260001  
Total Cost Not to Exceed: \$295,000

As part of the permitting process for the construction of the Mullica River Bridge, the NJDEP is requiring shellfish sampling and analysis, and water quality analysis before, during and after construction.

In order to satisfy the requirement, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority will execute agreements with NJDEP to secure the shellfish samples at a cost not to exceed \$125,000. In addition, the Authority will execute an agreement with Rutgers, NJ State University, Institute of Marine and Coastal Sciences to perform the laboratory analysis of the water and shellfish sampling obtained by the NJDEP, at a cost not to exceed \$170,000. Both agreements are presently being drafted and will not exceed the amounts indicated.

The repair and/or replacement of the fascia and first interior beams is required to restore the structural integrity of the bridge.
