# In an emergency dial 9-1-1 Anytime, Anywhere!!







Tell the **9-1-1** operator where you are, what your problem is, and the telephone number you are calling from. **STAY ON THE PHONE.** Answer all of the **9-1-1** operator's questions. If you can, do what the **9-1-1** operator tells you.

# In an emergency, another way to call for help is to use a...



cell phone.

In fact, you can even use your cell phone to text to **911** 

Sometimes it may not be safe to talk out loud, if that happens you can text for help!



Calling 9-1-1 is ALWAYS faster, so remember... Call If You Can, Text If You Can't

# The **9-1-1** operator can send help...



#### when there is a fire...



when someone is sick or hurt...



or when there is a crime.







If you smell smoke or see a fire in your home, yell "FIRE" and leave the house. DO NOT GO BACK IN THE HOUSE!





- Answer the 9-1-1 operator's questions and do what the 9-1-1 operator tells you.
- Stay with your neighbor. Do not go back for anything.
- The **9-1-1** operator will send the fire department to put out the fire.
