REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering or Physical or Natural Science including or supplemented by a minimum of (18) semester hour credits distributed among soil science, plant science, and natural resource or land use management. Please upload a copy of your transcripts with your application. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility.

NOTE: Possession of a valid Professional Engineer's License issued by the New Jersey State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree in Engineering. Applicants will be required to have the indicated (18) semester hours distributed among soil science, plant science, and natural resource or land use management. If you are substituting a Professional Engineer's License for the Bachelor's Degree, please upload a copy of your license with your application. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years experience in work relating to the conservation of natural resources, two (2) years of which shall have involved implementation of soil erosion and sedimentation control programs.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering or Physical or Natural Science may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated experience other than that required in soil erosion and sedimentation control programs. If you are substituting a Master's Degree for one (1) year of indicated experience, please upload a copy of your transcripts with your application. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility.

NOTE: A Doctorate degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering or Physical or Natural Science may be substituted for two (2) years of the indicated experience other than that required in soil erosion and sedimentation control programs. If you are substituting a Doctorate Degree for two (2) years of indicated experience, please upload a copy of your transcripts with your application. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility.

Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service. Please upload a copy of your evaluation with your application. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority.
