State Premier Chapter Awards

FFA Premier Chapter Awards recognize outstanding FFA chapters that demonstrate excellence in growing leaders, building communities, and strengthening agriculture.



Eligibility

- The chapter must be in good standing with the New Jersey State FFA Association at the time of application.
- Applications can only include activities that have occurred between April 1 of the previous school year and March 31 of the current school year.
- The chapter must compete Form II to be eligible.
- Chapters DO NOT need to receive a Gold Ranking to be eligible for the State Premier Chapter Awards.
- A chapter can be recognized with more than one of the State Premier Chapter Awards.

Overview

- Only applications generated in AET will be accepted.
- The application must be submitted through AET (Submission List) by April 1st or date listed in the current Calendar of Events. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
- Three State Premier Chapter Awards will be awarded - Growing Leaders Premier Chapter Award, Building Communities Premier Chapter Award, and Strengthening Agriculture Premier Chapter Award.

- Corduroy Banner (per division)
- Monetary Award: \$150 (per division)

Additional Information

- The top-ranking chapter in the Growing Leaders division will receive the Growing Leaders Premier Chapter
- The top-ranking chapter in the Building Communities division will receive the Building Communities Premier Chapter Award. This award supplants the Outstanding Community Service Project Award.
- The top-ranking chapter in the Strengthening Agriculture division will receive the Strengthening Agriculture Premier Chapter Award. This award supplants the Agricultural Awareness Award.
