

Star Greenhand Award Application



The New Jersey FFA Star Award program is designed to recognize the most outstanding production, agribusiness, placement, and agriscience based SAE programs at the state level.



Eligibility

- Applicants must appear on the roster of an FFA chapter in good standing with the New Jersey State FFA Association.
- Applicants must have received the Greenhand Degree in the school year prior to applying.
- Applicants MUST have been selected by their respective chapter for local level recognition in the school year prior to applying.
- Only one application per chapter is permissible.

Overview

- The Star Greenhand Award is based on application only.
- Only applications generated in AET will be accepted.
- The application must be submitted through AET (Submission List) by November 1st or date listed in the current Calendar of Events. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
- Applicants are notified via email regarding the status of their application.
- Only one state award will be given.
