

# Star Chapter Award Application

*The New Jersey FFA Star Award program is designed to recognize the most outstanding production, agribusiness, placement, and agriscience based SAE programs at the state level.*



## Eligibility

- Applicants must appear on the roster of an FFA chapter in good standing with the New Jersey State FFA Association.
- Applicants must have received the Chapter Degree in the school year prior to applying.
- Applicants MUST have been selected by their respective chapter for local level recognition in the school year prior to applying.
- Only one application per category per chapter is permissible.

## Overview

- Star Chapter Awards are based on application only.
- Only applications generated in AET will be accepted.
- The application must be submitted through AET (Submission List) by November 1st or date listed in the current Calendar of Events. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
- If an applicant has SAE projects in multiple categories, the applicant must choose the SAE project(s) in the category in which they are applying. An applicant can only apply in one category.
- Applicants should read the description of each category carefully before applying. The New Jersey State FFA Association is not responsible for students who apply in the wrong category.
- Applicants are notified via email regarding the status of their application.
- Up to four state awards will be presented – one for each category (farmer, agribusiness, placement, agriscience).

## The Application

### Awards

- Certificate
- Monetary Award: \$100 (per category)

### Additional Information

- Star Farmer: ownership/ entrepreneurship in production agriculture
- Star in Agribusiness: ownership/ entrepreneurship in non-production agriculture.
- Star in Agricultural Placement: working for an agricultural producer or agribusiness; unpaid or paid
- Star Agriscience: planning and conducting a scientific experiment based on a hypothesis and the use of the scientific method

### Essays

- Describe the SAE project(s) included in this application as completely and specifically as possible in the space allowed.
- Briefly explain how your roles, responsibilities, and/or management decisions related to this award area changed.
