SUBJECT: Fruit, Vegetable and Turkey Production

LESSON SUMMARY: This farm produces a large variety of fruits and vegetables as well as turkeys. Students will gain a foundation and basic understanding of plant science, animal science, pest management and marketing.

OBJECTIVES:

- To gain familiarity with growing plants for food.
- To introduce students to the fundamentals of weed, disease and pest management.
- Students will learn the animal husbandry practices used in turkey production.
- To understand the many tasks required to successfully grow crops.
