Resolution #2025-1 of the New Jersey One Health Task Force, Expressing Support for Interagency Coordination in Social Media Posts Across the Departments of Agriculture, Health, and Environmental Protection

WHEREAS, members of the New Jersey Departments of Health, Agriculture, and Environmental Protection work closely together to protect the health of New Jersey residents, animals, and environments, and continuing and strengthening interagency coordination is a major objective of the New Jersey One Health Task Force; and

WHEREAS, a coordinated interagency approach to social media communications (such as sharing each other's posts and graphics, tagging each other, and using the hashtags #OneHealth and #NJOneHealth) would amplify the reach of important messages, while providing a visible example of One Health coordination in action and promoting One Health awareness, another key objective of the Task Force;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the New Jersey One Health Task Force expresses support for planned coordination among the Departments of Health, Agriculture, and Environmental Protection on social media messaging relevant to One Health, specifically, posts on awareness dates and prevention messages related to:

- 1. Vector-borne diseases
- 2. Zoonotic diseases
- 3. Antimicrobial resistance and stewardship
- 4. Climate impacts on health, including as a threat multiplier
- 5. Environmental contaminants
- 6. Emergency preparedness
