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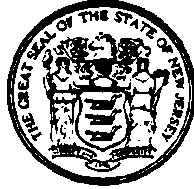

The Board will consider New Jersey Natural Gas Company's 2023 Societal Benefits Charge rate filing. The parties have executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, will result in a monthly increase of \$1.14 for a typical residential customer.
