- A.** Docket No. ER26060356 – In the Matter of the 2026/2027 Annual Compliance Filings for a Change in the Statewide Electric and Gas Permanent Universal Service Fund Program Factors Within the Electric and Gas Societal Benefits Charges Rates Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-21 and N.J.S.A. 48:2-21.1.

The Board will consider a filing made by the electric and gas distribution companies requesting adjustments to the statewide electric and gas Universal Service Fund program and Lifeline program rates within the Societal Benefits Charge.
