#### BY THE BOARD:1

On October 9, 2014, Edward E. Curran ("Petitioner"), filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with South Jersey Gas Company ("Respondent") for utility services rendered by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") W. Todd Miller.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on July 31, 2015, and received by the Board on August 7, 2015, to which the Settlement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Miller found that the Settlement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy, and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement, and in order to fully resolve this matter, the parties have agreed to the following:

- 1. Respondent shall credit \$2,000.00 to Petitioner's account for gas service in full satisfaction and settlement of the billing dispute.
- 2. To satisfy the remainder of the outstanding bill, which is estimated to be approximately \$4,000.00, Petitioner shall continue to pay \$937.00 per month until the outstanding balance is fully paid.
- 3. In addition to the agreement that the Settlement fully resolves any and all disputes associated with the billing dispute, Respondent agrees that it will not pursue any further action associated with the illegal connection of gas service.

After review of the record and the Settlement Agreement of the parties, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the Settlement as evidenced by their signatures and that by the terms of the Settlement Agreement have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter.

Accordingly, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and the Settlement Agreement executed by the parties in their entirety as if fully set forth herein.

The effective date of this Order shall be September 21, 2015.



This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law on February 24, 2. Gerbana 2015, for determination as a contested case, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 to -13.

The parties have agreed to a settlement and have prepared a Settlement Agreement indicating the terms thereof, which is attached and fully incorporated herein.

I have reviewed the record and the terms of settlement and I FIND:

1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures or their representatives' signatures and as placed on the record on January 15, 2015.

2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.

I CONCLUDE that this agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-13.1 and that the settlement should be approved. I approve the settlement and therefore ORDER that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be concluded.

If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.
