BY THE BOARD:

South Jersey Gas Company ("SJG" or "Company"), a regulated public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board"), is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey engaged in the business of transmission and distribution of natural gas to approximately 360,000 customers within its service territory.

SJG currently provides natural gas service within Woolwich Township ("Township") to approximately 3,560 residential, 122 commercial and three (3) industrial customers. The Company's consent to use the streets within the Township for the provision of gas service expired on October 27, 1997, pursuant to the fifty (50) year statutory limitation set forth in N.J.S.A. 48:3-15. A copy of the original ordinance is attached to this Order as Exhibit "A". On March 6, 2017 pursuant to Ordinance No. 2017-01, the Township renewed its consent and granted SJG continued permission to lay and construct its pipes, mains, and related appurtenances and facilities within the streets, alleys, squares and public places within the Township for a period of fifty (50) years to furnish gas service in the Township. By letter dated March 8, 2017, the Company accepted and agreed to the terms of the consent. Copies of the

¹ The Board notes that municipal consents often expire some time prior to their renewal even when the Company initiates the renewal process prior to the expiration of the previous term. This is primarily the result of the time necessary for a municipality to fulfill the legal requirements that attend to all formal actions it must take along with the additional time for hearing and Board approval as required by law. The Board has been assured that pending review of this petition, SJG has continued to provide service to its customers within the Township in an uninterrupted manner.

Ordinance and the letter of acceptance are attached to this Order as Exhibits "B" and "C" respectively.

On March 17, 2017, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-14 and N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.5, SJG filed a petition requesting that the Board approve the consent adopted by the Township. As required by law and after notice, a hearing in this matter was held on July 28, 2017. William Agee, Esq., the Board's duly appointed hearing officer, presided over the hearing. Appearances were made on behalf of the Company, the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel ("Rate Counsel") and Board Staff. No other party participated in the hearing or filed any written submission with the Board related to this proceeding.

At the hearing, the Company relied on its petition and exhibits filed with the Board and presented the testimony of Joseph Schneider, its General Manager of Compliance, Standards and Records. According to the petition, SJG anticipates growth in its defined service territory to be approximately one percent (1%) annually for the next three (3) to five (5) years. Mr. Schneider testified that the Company has the capacity to meet the anticipated level of growth within the municipality.

Rate Counsel, in its written comments to the petition dated August 18, 2017, indicated that it does not object to the Company's petition since the Company represented that it has the capacity necessary to continue to provide natural gas service to the Township, and since the term of the municipal consent related to the use of streets is limited to the statutory maximum term of fifty (50) years. However, Rate Counsel requests that approval of the petition include certain restrictions which are incorporated in this Order.

Following its receipt of Rate Counsel's comments, SJG filed correspondence with the Board on August 29, 2017 indicating that it had no additional comments.

After a full review of the entire record, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that the municipal consent for use of the streets, which is the subject of this matter, is necessary and proper for the public convenience and properly serves the public interest, and that SJG has the ability to continue to provide safe, adequate and proper service. The Board <u>FURTHER FINDS</u> that the Company has the necessary experience, financial capability, capacity, and facilities in the Township to continue to provide adequate and appropriate service to its existing customers, as well as expected future customers, and that the fifty (50) year duration of the municipal consent to use the streets is consistent with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:3-15. Accordingly, the Board, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:2-14, <u>HEREBY APPROVES</u> the consent granted to SJG by the Township to continue to provide gas service, and for the continued use of its public streets for that purpose for a period of fifty (50) years.

The approval granted hereinabove shall be subject to the following provisions:

- This Order shall not be construed as directly or indirectly fixing for any purposes whatsoever the value of any tangible or intangible assets now owned or hereafter to be owned by SJG.
- This Order shall not effect nor in any way limit the exercise of the authority of this Board or of the State in any future petition or in any proceedings with respect to rates, franchises, services, financing, accounting, capitalization, depreciation, or in any other matters affecting SJG.

This Order shall be effective as of October 2, 2017.

WHEREAS, South Jersey Gas Company, a corporation of the State of New Jersey, provides natural gas service to Woolwich Township pursuant to municipal consent first granted to South Jersey Gas Company via the adoption of an Ordinance on October 27, 1947; and

WHEREAS, South Jersey Gas Company now seeks, pursuant to N.I.S.A. 48:3-15, the consent of Woolwich Township to allow the continued use of municipal streets in Woolwich Township by adopting the following Ordinance;
