In the Matter of the Application of Comcast of Plainfield, LLC for a System-Wide Cable Television Franchise in the Borough of Dunellen

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to the “Cable Television Act,” N.J.S.A. 48:5A-16(f), the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“NJBP” or “Board”) hereby gives notice of virtual public hearings to discuss the application of Comcast of Plainfield, LLC (“Comcast”) for a system-wide franchise.

Background

On March 14, 2024, Comcast filed an application (“Application”) with the Board’s Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications, requesting a system-wide franchise to offer cable television service in the Borough of Dunellen (“Dunellen”), located in Middlesex County, New Jersey. Comcast currently serves a total of three (3) municipalities under its traditional municipal consent-based cable television franchises.
