NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR COMMENTS¹

ADOPTION OF THE PROGRAM YEAR 4 TECHNICAL REFERENCE MANUAL FOR NEW JERSEY'S TRIENNIUM 2 ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS

Docket No. QO23030150

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Staff of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") hereby invites all interested parties and members of the public to submit comments on a revised proposed Technical Reference Manual ("TRM") for the State's Energy Efficiency Triennium Program Year 4 ("PY4 TRM").

The TRM is a compendium of engineering equations and guidelines used to calculate the energy savings that arise from New Jersey's energy efficiency programs, including programs available through New Jersey's Clean Energy Program and public electric utility and public gas utility companies. The Board, through the TRM Committee, within the Evaluation, Measurement & Verification ("EM&V") Working Group established by the Board, manages the process by which the TRM is annually updated. The TRM Committee approved the PY4 TRM draft which, the EM&V Working Group then approved on October 9, 2024.

The PY4 TRM is an evolution of the 2023 TRM, with changes that address:²

- Error corrections and editorial changes
- Updates to selected measure sections
- Addition of new measures
- Incorporation of PY2 Evaluation results
