² On May 23, 2018, Governor Phil Murphy signed into law L. 2018, c. 16 (codified at N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.3 to -87.7) ("Act"). The Act requires the Board to create a program and mechanism for the issuance of Zero Emission Certificates, each of which is intended to represent the fuel diversity, air quality, and other environmental attributes of one megawatt-hour of electricity generated by an eligible nuclear power plant selected by the Board to participate in the program.
