RESOLUTION 2024-260
APPROVAL OF APPLICATION TO CHANGE LOCATION: ACREAGE CCF NEW JERSEY LLC

WHEREAS, P.L.2019, c.153, “Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act,” (“the Honig Act”) authorizes a process for the receipt of applications and issuance of permits to operate Alternative Treatment Centers (“ATCs”) in the state of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the authority to regulate and enforce activities related to medicinal cannabis is vested in the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“the Commission”) pursuant to the Honig Act; and

WHEREAS, the regulations for medicinal cannabis provide a process at N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8 for amendments to an Alternative Treatment Center permit, including changes of the ATC’s location; and

WHEREAS, the entity listed below has followed the requirements set forth at N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8, for the amendment to its medicinal cannabis permit; and

WHEREAS, the entity listed below has provided an agreement for the purchase of the 35 Crescent Boulevard location, a Resolution from Collingswood evidencing their support for a future Class 5 Retailer in Collingswood, and a Patient Transition Plan which includes notifying patients of their other Atlantic City-based options for acquiring cannabis; and

WHEREAS, Acreage is requesting authorization to shut down their Atlantic City facility upon approval of the transfer, and in advance of opening at the new location in Collingswood without relinquishing its permit back to the NJ-CRC; and

WHEREAS, approval of this entity’s application to amend its dispensary permit and change its location to a new location in a municipality that has authorized medicinal cannabis is beneficial to the medicinal patient population near the new location;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8, the following Alternative Treatment Center is **APPROVED** to change its dispensary location as proposed in its submission to the Commission, pending payment of the requisite fees for the amendment to its medicinal cannabis permit in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.10, and is authorized to close their Atlantic City facility upon payment of the requisite fees:

Amendments to the medical permit shall not be executed until Acreage CCF New Jersey, LLC passes a final onsite assessment of the Collingswood facility. Acreage CCF New Jersey, LLC shall not conduct any medical dispensing activities at the Collingswood facility until it receives an amended medical permit authorizing it to commence such activities.
