Vacating Extension of Safe-Use Campaign Contract

Adjustment of Social Equity Excise Fee for 2025

- Fee imposed on licensed adult-use market cannabis cultivators
- Fee determination based on:
 - N.J.A.C. 17:30-3.4(c)(2) . . . If the average retail price of an ounce of usable cannabis in the current calendar year is at least \$250.00, but less than \$350.00, the excise fee shall be: i. \$ 30.00 per ounce of usable cannabis; and ii. \$ 8.00 per ounce of unusable cannabis sold for the purpose of manufacturing.



Adjustment of Social Equity Excise Fee for 2025

- Fee set at \$30/ounce of usable cannabis due to statewide average retail price of \$330.68
- Fee set at \$8/ounce of unusable cannabis sold for the purpose of manufacturing
