

#### **Chair's Report: Online Waiver Form**

#### **Rule Waiver Request**

Use this form to request that the Cannabis Regulatory Commission waive a regulatory requirement for you or your business. A waiver is only permissible if the waiver: (1) is necessary to achieve the purpose of the Jake Honig Act or CREAMM Act; (2) is necessary to provide access to cannabis items to consumers; **and** (3) does not create a danger to the public health, safety, or welfare

After submitting a request, the Commission will review the request and decide whether to grant or deny the request. You may withdraw your request at any time by sending an email to <a href="mailto:Daniel.Said@crc.nj.gov">Daniel.Said@crc.nj.gov</a> with a copy (cc) to <a href="mailto:CRC.Legal@crc.nj.gov">CRC.Legal@crc.nj.gov</a>.

- The NJ-CRC is here to help, but only YOU can make a business successful





#### Medicinal & Recreational Sales (Last Four Quarters\*)











Year Over Year Change, June 2024 - June 2025: 39.3%



# THCA Testing Value Averages 2023 – 2025 YTD


















### Total Sales by Month (June 2024 – June 2025) - Social Equity

Total Sales Last 12 Months (Jun 2024 - Jun 2025) - Social Equity










## Total Sales by Month (June 2024 – June 2025) - Minority Owned




Year Over Year Change, June 2024 - June 2025: 70.5%



## Rescind waiver of N.J.A.C. 17:30-11.5(c)(2) and -11.6(b) under Resolution 2023-144 (AU edibles)

- Rescinds a temporary waiver granted in 2023 allowing manufacturers to make non-TCS edibles
- Temporary waiver no longer needed, as permanent rule changes now in place, including:
  - Expanded to allow ingestible products
  - Clarified ingredient standards

### Rescind Authority to Issue Provisional Badges Under Resolution 2024-199



### Rescind Authority to Issue Provisional Badges Under Resolution 2024-199

- Ends the policy allowing issuance of provisional employee ID cards for ATC and AU cannabis business employees
- Rescinds Resolution 2024-199, which temporarily allowed employment with a provisional employee ID card while background checks were pending



#### Vote:

To approve rescinding authority to issue provisional badges under Resolution 2024-199





- Target audiences include:
  - Youth under 18
  - Young adults (18-20)
  - Parents/guardians of small children
  - Inexperienced consumers or those considering cannabis use
  - Pregnant and nursing people
  - Cannabis tourists
  - Those with compromising health conditions



- A multilingual approach to reflect the state's predominant languages
- A multi-channel campaign
- Primary goals include:
  - Promoting safe-use practices among adults
  - Promoting teen deterrence
  - Educating consumers about keeping small children safe
  - Promoting dangers of impaired driving



- Mini-bid distributed on April 24, 2025
- Contract timeline: One (1) year
- Nine (9) proposals received by May 5, 2025, deadline
- Staff Evaluation Committee scored each using objective evaluation criteria
- Budget: **\$1,000,000**
