RESOLUTION 2026-07-16-10
REGULATION WAIVER REQUEST – DOCKET NO. WR060

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“the Commission”), established pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153, known and cited as the “Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act,” is charged with implementing the provisions of that Act as well as P.L.2021, c.16, known and cited as the “New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act”; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-3.7(a), The Commission, in accordance with the general purposes and intent of the Act and this chapter, may waive a regulatory requirement regarding the operations of a cannabis business, to the extent such waiver does not conflict with any other State law, if in the Commission's determination, such a waiver: (1) is necessary to achieve the purpose of the Act; (2) is necessary to provide access to cannabis items to consumers; and (3) does not create a danger to the public health, safety, or welfare; and

WHEREAS, under Docket Number WR060, Curaleaf NJ II, Inc. (Winslow), requests a waiver of the regulatory requirement that a license holder shall manage non-hazardous unusable cannabis, cannabis waste, or cannabis items, including returned, recalled, or usable cannabis or cannabis products that have expired, by either: destroying the material through incineration; or rendering the material unrecoverable, unrecognizable, and useless for diversion, and then disposing of the material by either transporting it off-site as compost or solid waste or composting it on-site; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed the entity’s waiver request and determined that the facts and circumstances as articulated in the entity’s request *does not* meet the requirements of N.J.A.C. 17:30-3.7(a);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission, that the above waiver request is **DENIED**. The Commission’s reasons for denying this waiver request shall be set forth in the Final Agency Decision sent to the entity.
