RESOLUTION 2021-

CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF HARMONY FOUNDATION FOR PERMITTING OF A SECOND CULTIVATION SITE

WHEREAS, P.L. 2021, c.16, "The New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act," ("the Act") authorizes an alternative treatment center that was issued a permit prior to the effective date of P.L. 2021, c.16 or that was issued a permit after the effective date of P.L. 2019, c.16, pursuant to an application submitted prior to the effective date of P.L. 2021, c.16, to cultivate medical cannabis from up to two physical locations, provided that the alternative treatment center's combined mature cannabis plant grow canopy between both locations shall not exceed 150,000 square feet of bloom space or the square footage of canopy permitted under the largest tier in the tiered system adopted by the Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("the Commission"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the authorities and requirements in N.J.S.A. 24:6I-1 et seq. and the corresponding rules at N.J.A.C. 8:64-1.1 et seq., an application for a second cultivation site was submitted by the alternative treatment center identified below to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission staff in the Office of Compliance and Licensing reviewed the application submitted, including information concerning the applicant's financial sources, compliance with criminal background checks, verification of information pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:64-7.2, and compliance with operational regulations and requirements found in Chapter 64 of Title 8 of the Administrative Code pertaining to cultivation and general alternative treatment center operations for the site; and

WHEREAS, Commission staff has conducted site visits and reviewed site plans for compliance with the provisions of Title 8, Chapter 64 of the Administrative code pertaining to cultivation and general alternative treatment center operations; and

WHEREAS, based on the review, Commission staff have determined that Harmony Foundation is authorized by N.J.S.A. 24:6I-7 to maintain two cultivation sites, has justified the need for the expanded cultivation capacity at the Lafayette facility based on patient need, has submitted a complete application with all the necessary information required by the Commission to make a determination on the request, and has established site control and local approval for the property and their plans;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission that:

- 1. The application to operate a second medical cannabis cultivation location submitted by the Harmony Foundation pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153 as noted above is hereby approved, pending final inspection.
- 2. At the appropriate time, Harmony Foundation may submit a request for the use of structures for cultivation in a manner that complies with Commission regulations.
