Cannabis impairs driving. Impaired driving is against the law.

If I used cannabis, how long should I wait to drive?

The duration of your cannabis high varies by consumption method: smoking or vaping may last up to six hours, while gummies, edibles, tablets, lozenges, tinctures, beverages, and other consumibles can last up to 12 hours.

How does cannabis use affect my driving?

Cannabis reduces reaction time, making it more difficult to respond to unexpected hazards or sudden changes in road conditions.

Cannabis may alter your perception of speed and distance, leading to unsafe speeding and insufficient braking time.

Cannabis can impair vision and coordination, making it difficult to see and steer properly.



Cannabis may cause drowsiness.

PENALTIES FOR DRIVING HIGH

Operating a vehicle while impaired puts your safety and the safety of others at risk and can lead to serious consequences. These may include:



Arrest with DUI* charges
(*Driving Under the Influence)



Court fines & fees



Vehicle impoundment



Imprisonment

Before you use cannabis or any other substance that causes impairment, make arrangements for transportation. Options include designated drivers, public transportation, rideshares, and taxis.
